### **Stafford King Wiese Architects Awarded In-Patient Pharmacy Project at Kaiser Permanente Morse Avenue Hospital**

Sacramento, California, June 2006 — StaffordKingWiese ARCHITECTS has been awarded the In-Patient Pharmacy project at Kaiser Permanente's Morse Avenue Hospital in Sacramento, CA. The first phase of the project is to conduct a feasibility/scoping study of converting the existing In-Patient Pharmacy to comply with USP 797 requirements, which is scheduled to be complete by the end of August 2006. The scope includes converting the existing work area into a Compounding Sterile Clean Room (ISO Class 5) with an Ante Room (ISO Class 8), with proper ventilation in a controlled environment to maintain a clean and safe work space.
