Stafford King Wiese Architects Celebrates Ribbon Cutting for RIO LINDA HIGH SCHOOL & COMMUNITY POOL

Sacramento, California, February, 2006 — Stafford King Wiese ARCHITECTS joined Grant Joint Union High School District, Rio Linda High School and the Rio Linda community in celebrating the completion of the joint-use school and community pool. This pool will allow the school and community to have swim meets, lessons and recreation in the warmer months. This is the only community pool north of Interstate 80 in Sacramento County.

The pool complex consists of a toilet and locker rooms, an office building and mechanical room totaling 2,240 sf. The complex consists of two pools. The first pool is a competition pool with water polo goal and starting platforms as well as a hydraulic lift to assist disabled individuals into the water. The second pool is a recreational zero entry pool with water slide and water feature (rain drop). There are also bleachers for spectators.
